SHERMAN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS ON FEBRUARY 14, 2023 AT 11:30 A.M.

A meeting of the Sherman Economic Development Corporation Board of Directors was convened in the SEDCO Board Room, 307 W. Washington St, Ste 102, Sherman, Texas on February 14, 2023, at 11:30 a.m.

CALL TO ORDER, QUORUM DETERMINED, MEETING DECLARED OPEN, RECOGNITION OF GUESTS, INVOCATION

Mrs. Bates called the meeting to order at 11:30 a.m., declared a quorum present, meeting declared open.

The invocation was given by Mr. Sharp.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no public comments.

DISCUSS AND CONSIDER APPROVAL OF THE FOLLOWING MINUTES

Motion was made by Ms. Utter and seconded by Mr. Bandemir to approve the Regular Scheduled Meeting Minutes of January 10, 2023. Motion was approved unanimously.

DISCUSS AND CONSIDER APPROVAL OF THE FOLLOWING FINANCIAL REPORTS

Mr. Sharp presented the Balance Sheet, Budget Report, Anomalies, and Commitments for the month ending December 31, 2022 and reported the following:

- Cash SEDCO Checking: \$ 2,296,391.69
- Accounts Payable: \$ 24,823.47
- Fund Balance: \$ 16,288,563.45
- Revenues Over/Under Expenses: \$ 1,298,272.60
- Total Liabilities, Equity and Current Surplus (Deficit): \$ 17,611,659.52
- Revenue Total: 25.81%
- Expense Total: 7.07%

On the Anomalies Report, Mr. Sharp noted the Luncheons & Meetings account was recorded as 111.91% used and that was due to the meal for the City of Sherman employee Christmas party. On the Commitments Report, Mr. Sharp reported two projects that expired on December 31, 2022 which included Emerson Automation Solutions Final Control and Eternity Technologies, Inc.

Motion was made by Mr. Bandemir and seconded by Mr. Brumm to approve the financial reports for the month ending December 31, 2022. Motion was approved unanimously.

Mrs. Lawrence presented the Investment Report for Quarter Ending December 31, 2022 and reported the portfolio book value and market value were approximately \$15.3 million. Of this amount, \$3.0 million was held in a Local Government Investment Pool (LGIP), \$6 million was held in Certificates of Deposit (CD), and \$6.3 million was held in an FDIC insured investment account. Activity during the quarter included interest earned on the investments, a CD maturity of \$1.5 million, and a CD deposit of \$3.0 million. The weighted average yield on the

portfolio was 3.40%, 102 basis points below the three-month Constant Maturity Treasury Index of 4.42%, and 148 basis points above the previous quarter. The weighted average maturity for the portfolio increased from 161 days at September 30, 2022 to 187 days at December 31, 2022.

Motion to approve the SEDCO Investment Report for quarter ending December 31, 2022, was made by Ms. Utter and seconded by Dr. Hambrick. Motion was approved unanimously.

SALES TAX AND ECONOMIC BAROMETER REPORTS

Mr. Sharp reported a 17.91% cumulative year-to-date sales tax for the month of February.

Ms. Bellows presented the January 2023 Economic Barometer Report and reported the following:

- New residential permits were down 74%, and commercial and industrial permits were down 25% compared to January 2022. There was one new multi-family permit for a 276-unit apartment complex on OB Groner Road.
- The city was up 372 customers from last January.
- January's sales tax saw a 34% increase.
- In December, Grayson County's months supply of housing inventory was 3.6 months, down from 3.8 months in November.
- Sherman's unemployment rate increased from 3.3% in November to 3.4% in December.
