



2. **Executive Session**
The Sherman Economic Development Corporation will hold an Executive Session pursuant to the provisions of the Open Meetings Law, Chapter 551, Government Code, Vernon's Texas Code Annotated, in accordance with the authority contained in the following sections:
- Section 551.087** – Economic Development: Discussion concerning the following projects:
Wood, Heather
- Section 551.072** – Real Property: Discussion concerning: 58 Aggie Assignment Agreement, Bank of Texas Office Lease Agreement
- Section 551.071.** – Consultation with Attorney; Closed Meeting. A governmental body may not conduct a private consultation with its attorney except:
- (1) when the governmental body seeks the advice of its attorney about:
- (A) pending or contemplated litigation; or
- (B) a settlement offer; or
- (2) on a matter in which the duty of the attorney to the governmental body under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas clearly conflicts with this chapter.
- Section 551.074** – Personnel Matters: Authorizes certain deliberations about officers and employees of the governmental body to be held in executive session:
- (a) This chapter does not require a governmental body to conduct an open meeting:
- (1) to deliberate the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a public officer or employee; or
- (2) to hear a complaint or a charge against an officer or employee.
- (b) Subsection (a) does not apply if the officer or employee who is the subject of the deliberation or hearing requests a public hearing.
3. Reconvene open meeting and consider items discussed in Executive Session
4. Adjournment
